Conference Registration

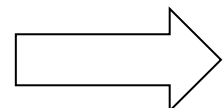
Master Joiners will reimburse the Registration Fee if the apprentice chooses to attend the whole conference.

CRITERIA

- Entries must be minimum 80% completed entirely by the apprentice.
- Where any apprentice has completed his time within 12 months of the closing date of the competition, he/she may enter a project retrospectively, providing the work was completed before their final qualification and meets the 80%+ completed by the apprentice criteria.
- Entries will be judged on the following:
 - ❖ Level of workmanship and skill
 - ❖ Use of materials
 - ❖ Complexity of project
 - ❖ Visual appeal

RULES & GUIDELINES

Enter any project manufactured by your company which has been a minimum of 80% completed entirely by you, the apprentice.

PRESENTATION

Although category awards will be judged on content, board presentation is important.

PHOTOGRAPHS

All photographs are acceptable but the clearer or higher resolution the photos are, the easier they are to judge and be reproduced in future publications. Photos of detail in the technical construction are beneficial to the judging. The right to use these photographs for publicity is agreed on the entry form.

AWARDS

The winner of each category will be announced and presented with a prize and certificate on the night of the Awards Dinner in Invercargill on Saturday 22 June 2019, at the Master Joiners Conference. Certificates may also be awarded for entries of special merit.

JUDGES

Registered Master Joiners will appoint a minimum of three judges. The judges' decisions are final.

HOW TO ENTER

- ❑ Fill in the entry form and email to awards@masterjoiners.co.nz or post to Master Joiners Apprentice Awards, 13a Charles Street, Napier 4110 **before Thursday 18 April 2019**
- ❑ Use the template guide provided to present your award entry to the same address **by Thursday 18 April 2019.**
- ❑ Entry is **open to all joinery apprentices in New Zealand** and entry is free.

GENERAL

- Entries to be A2 size (approx 420 x 600mm) guided by the NZ Master Joiners Apprentice Awards Template Guide, backed by one layer of corflute or heavyweight cardboard, and displayed in landscape (horizontal) format.
- Past projects previously entered in these awards cannot be re-entered in the same or another category.
- No name of the manufacturer/business owner or Apprentice is to be displayed initially on the face of the entry
- Identification (through business card or typewritten memo) should be pasted to the back of your entry and a further business card or memo (90mm x 55mm) supplied, to be attached to the front for display at conference.
- Entries will be judged on photographic and written matter only
- Entries may remain in the custody of Master Joiners for promotional purposes for 3 months following the event
- USB, CD or Dropbox of high resolution photos used, plus a photo of the finished Entry Board, must be included with each entry
- The owner of the property must sign the form acknowledging agreement to enter
- The employer of the entrant must sign the form verifying 80% or more of the work has been completed by the apprentice
- No samples or material swatches to be included or attached to the boards, nor anything protruding beyond the face.
- Entry Forms and Project Boards must be with the Master Joiners Awards Administrator **by Thursday 18 April 2019**
