- 1. No names of individuals
- 2. No company names
- 3. No regional identifying information

When using this template please remember to check the following points before saving as a PDF and submitting your board online.

- 1. Has the space for administration use only been kept clear? This is where your business card will be affixed to the board after judging is completed, will it fit comfortably?
- 2. Has the border margin been kept clear? This is important for printing purposes.
- 3. Boards are to be A2 (approx. 420x600mm) size in horizontal format.
- 4. Are you entering the **Master Joiner** awards or the **Apprentice** awards? Be sure to state which program you are entering. Visit the awards web page for the list of categories you can enter.
- 5. Have you clearly listed the award categories you are entering the award board into?
- 6. Are the photo images the best possible resolution? Boards entered with images that are pixelation or the resolution is too high will result in the images being affected when printed. Please include images of the manufacturing of the product as best you can.
- 7. Make sure your board has **no unique identifying** features. **You cannot have names of individuals, companies, regions or logos.**
- 8. Submit your PDF award board via the online entry portal and our electronic business card.
- 9. You may submit additional images for the judge's exclusive use to judge the project.
- 10. Include details in the project narrative which demonstrate the skills, workmanship and complexity involved. If entering the compliant timber joinery category, please state in the narrative how it is compliant i.e. what standard does it meet.
